

The **Great Minds Fellowship** is ideal for students looking to make a difference and contribute to growing Ohio's behavioral healthcare workforce. The program will help students jump start a successful future in their chosen career path while allowing communities across Ohio to better care for those living with mental health and substance abuse disorders.

WHAT IS IT?

At Ohio's two-year and four-year colleges and universities, the Great Minds Fellowship is a program available to students within two years of graduating with degrees or certificates in social work, marriage and family therapy, mental health counseling, psychiatric/mental health nursing, and substance abuse/addiction counseling.

HOW DOES IT WORK?

Great Minds Fellows at participating colleges and universities will be eligible for up to \$10,000 during their undergraduate and graduate studies for scholarship opportunities to assist with the costs of obtaining their degrees or certificates; paid internships at one of Ohio's Community Behavioral Health Centers (CBHC) at the undergraduate and graduate levels; and the costs of required license and certification preparation and exams (and other costs related to the degree or certificate). Funding will be available beginning in the fall 2023 semester.
